Celebrating Christmas at Tranmere and Charing Cross Methodist Churches

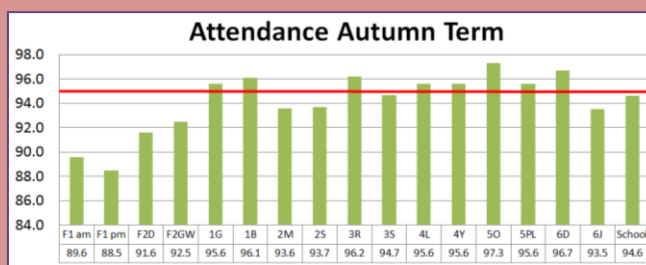
Christmas Eve – Christingle 5pm at Tranmere Methodist Church.
