Response:

There are different points of view from parents regarding homework and we understand both. At school we do see the good progress the children make if they regularly read at home and reinforce their learning through homework. Please speak to your child’s class teacher about homework concerns and they will be able to make sure your child can cope with the amount they receive.
