<p>Concerns</p> <p>“Teacher was running behind even though I was on time. Try to be on time please.”</p> <p>“My son says other children often disrupt him in class.”</p> <p>“I feel that lunchtime is too late for children in Year 6 and they don’t have enough time to eat.”</p> <p>“School Meals are too expensive”</p> <p>“Sometimes I do feel that we are told about things/events/situations a little bit late.”</p> <p>“My child had a bullying incident during playtime that was not attended to correctly as the teacher did not do anything”</p>	<p>Response</p> <p>We are sorry that this parent or any others were kept waiting long on parents evening. The teachers need to see a large amount of parents and some interviews overrun. We appreciate that some parents want to talk for longer than 10 minutes but we do try to keep to time.</p> <p>We do not accept any disruptive behaviour in class as the children’s learning is too important. If a child is disrupting others there is always a consequence. Please talk to your child’s class teacher if this continues to be a concern.</p> <p>With many children now having a school dinner it is more difficult to get all the children into the hall for lunch within lunchtime. We therefore stagger the times that they come in. Year 6 have been coming in last but are usually all in by 12.50, giving them 25 minutes for lunch. However, we will monitor this closely and may alternate with other year groups in future.</p> <p>Metro catering are the provider for our school meals, as they are for most schools on the Wirral. They have recently started providing only fresh food each day for all their meals which cost £2.30 a day. We do not think they would be able to make the meals for any less but will pass on the concern.</p> <p>We try hard to make sure we communicate well and in a timely way with parents. Letters can sometimes get dropped by children, so we also put news and events on our website. Please check the website regularly and we will try to ensure you are always informed of events well in advance.</p> <p>We are proud of the work that we do to prevent bullying in school and of our Anti-Bullying Quality Mark and therefore we were concerned to hear this. If you ever feel that an incident has not been dealt with to your satisfaction and your child is upset or worried please do not hesitate to speak to their teacher or a senior member of staff.</p>
