We will ask questions about a picture.

We will take turns in talking about our summer holiday.

We will take on different roles within our role play area.

### Writing Opportunities

We will write about our Summer holidays.

We will label weather forecast pictures.

We will label clothing.

We will fill in charts about what we have observed.

We will rewrite 'Peace at Last'.

### Maths Opportunities

We will learn about the four seasons, the months of the year and the days of the week.

We will learn about hours in the day and night.

We will have various counting, adding and subtracting experiences connected to our topic.

### Social, Moral, Spiritual, Cultural

We will work together cooperatively in role play and games.

We will take turns in talking and actively listening to each other during our Philosophy for Children (P4C) sessions.

We will learn that in parts of the world day and night are at different times.
