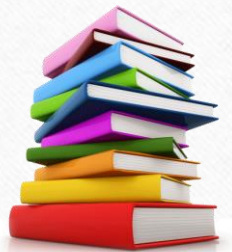
Homework

- Literacy or Maths homework goes home on a Friday and is expected to be returned the following Thursday.
- Spelling homework is given out on a Monday and should be returned on a Friday.

Reading at home

- Reading at home is one of the best ways you can help support your child and it is very important for your child to still be reading regularly at home.
- School reading books can be changed daily and should be changed at least once a week. There are additional 'I love reading' books as an incentive for our keen readers.
