

RED ZONE

Why might my name be moved into Red Zone?

Choosing not to follow the school's Code of Conduct:

'Be Nice, Work Hard, Never Give Up' including;

- Severe Unkind behaviour such as: physical assault; verbal abuse; on-going bullying;
- Severe Disruptive behaviour such as: total refusal to do what a member of staff has asked you to do;
- Severe Unsafe behaviour such as: leaving the school without permission; a need to remove you or other pupils from a specific area in school in order to maintain the safety of all;

If I move into Red Zone what will happen?

- A comment will be recorded on the school data system;
- The Headteacher/Deputy Headteacher/ Assistant Headteacher will be immediately involved;
- A phone call will be made to your parent/carer, and follow-up letter, to explain what has happened and the punishment that has been given. Your parent/carer will be invited into school to discuss your behaviour with the Headteacher/Deputy Headteacher / Assistant Headteacher and Class teacher;
- Internal exclusion: You will complete all your lessons, break and lunchtime away from your own class

If behaviour has resulted in Red Zone, you may be put onto a Behaviour Report, which could lead to a Behaviour Contract. If negative behaviour continues, this could result in exclusion from school.

ORANGE ZONE

Why might my name be moved into Orange Zone?

Choosing not to follow the school's Code of Conduct:

'Be Nice, Work Hard, Never Give Up' including;

- More Serious Unkind behaviour such as: deliberately hurting other people by what you do or what you say; bullying; stealing; destroying other people's belongings;
- More Serious Disruptive behaviour such as: continually preventing others to be able to get on with their work during lessons or their games during playtime; refusing to follow and instruction given by an adult;
- More Serious Unsafe behaviour such as: fighting; refusing to do what a member of staff has asked you to do; leaving the classroom or playground without permission;

If I move into Orange Zone what will happen?

- A comment will be recorded in the school data system;
- An Orange Zone letter will be produced for you to get signed by the Headteacher. The letter will be sent to your parent/carer, following a phone call;
- Loss of breaktime(s) and lunchtime(s), to be spent in the Orange Zone room, in silence (number of days to be determined by a senior member of staff)
- Loss of Golden Time;
- Possible loss of school trips, clubs and other rewards and privileges;

Behaviour continuously leading to orange zone may result in a behaviour panel meeting and you needing to be put on a behaviour report.

GREEN ZONE

Why might my name stay in Green Zone?

Choosing to follow the school's Code of Conduct:
'Be Nice, Work Hard, Never Give Up'
by showing your continuous good behaviour.

To make the right choice to improve your behaviour,
following a verbal warning.

If I stay in Green Zone what will happen?

- Full participation in rewards and privileges
- Being eligible for a lunchtime behaviour certificate;
- Full participation in Golden Time;
- Raffle ticket to be entered into the end of week assembly raffle
- Positive notes or phone call home and certificates at the end of the year

How do I stay in Green Zone?

- Continue to display behaviour of a high standard;
- Choose to act upon any advice given to amend your behaviour at the first request.

YELLOW ZONE

Why might my name be moved into Yellow Zone?

Choosing not to follow the school's Code of Conduct:
'Be Nice, Work Hard, Never Give Up' including;

- Unkind behaviour such as: hurting other people by what you do or what you say; not looking after other people's belongings, name-calling, telling hurtful lies;
- Disruptive behaviour such as: talking when you should be listening; interrupting; not settling to work; distracting others; tapping, fidgeting, swinging on chair
- Unsafe behaviour such as: not walking around school sensibly; using equipment in the wrong way; play fighting.

If I move into Yellow Zone what will happen?

- A comment will be recorded in the school data system;
- You will lose your break time;
- You will lose part of your Golden Time;

Behaviour continuously leading to yellow zone may result in a behaviour panel meeting and you needing to be put on a behaviour report.

Exclusions

Why might I be excluded (fixed term or permanent)?

Choosing not to follow the school's Code of Conduct: 'Be Nice, Work Hard, Never Give Up' including;

- A serious breach or persistent breaches of Behaviour Policy;
- Serious harm to education and welfare of pupils or others;
- Serious or threatened violence against another pupil or member of staff;
- Possession of or supplying an illegal drug;
- Carrying an offensive weapon;
- Use or threatened use of an offensive weapon;
- If allowing the pupil to remain in school would seriously harm the education or welfare of others.

This also includes behaviour outside of school that would bring the school's reputation into disrepute.

If I am excluded, what will happen?

- A comment will be recorded on the school data system;
- My parents/carers will be informed and I will need to be collected from school immediately;
- Work will be provided for me to complete when I am at home;
- I will have to remain indoors during normal school hours;
- If I am excluded for more than 5 days, I may have to attend another school for the rest of my exclusion.
- On my return I will have to attend a reintegration meeting with my parents/carers and senior members of staff.
