This presentation has been designed by the pupils of our school to show what they understand 'Never Give Up' to mean.

Each Year group were asked to devise their definition and then it was collected together to make a whole school definition.







In Year I, this is what we think it means to never give up:

- Don't stop
- Keep trying
- Ask for help

- Don't say 'l can't'





In Year 2, this is what we think it means to never give up:

- If something is tricky, keep trying
- If you aren't good at something, keep trying
- Ask for help
- Keep practising
- Use the working wall
- Don't say 'l can't'





In Year 3, this is what we think it means to never give up:

- Always try your best, you will get there in the end
- If you can't do something, keep trying and soon you will succeed
- Use everything you can to help you
- Keep practising
- Always finish the task set
- Try and solve hard problems
- Don't say 'l can't'





In Year 4, this is what we think it means to never give up:

- Try, try and try again
- Always do your work even though it is hard
- Never get angry with your work
- Keep practising
- If you are really stuck- don't start chatting
- Try your best in all your subjects
- Don't say 'l can't'
- Believe in yourself YOU CAN DO IT!





In Year 5, this is what we think it means to never give up:

- Don't stop and give up with your work, there's always an answer
- If you find it tricky, keep trying
- Ask for help if you need to
- Keep practising
- Believe in yourself
- Persevere with difficult things
- Don't say 'l can't'
- If at first you don't succeed, try, try again!





In Year 6, this is what we think it means to never give up:

- If something is difficult, don't give up
- If you fail at your first attempt, keep trying
- Believe and you will succeed
- Don't doubt yourself
- Try not to get frustrated if you find something difficult
- Keep practicing and you will get better
- Don't say 'l can't'



In summary, this is what we think it means to never give up:

- If something is difficult try harder to do it
- Don't be afraid to ask for help
- If something goes wrong- don't give up on it- have another try
- Keep practicing until you can do it
