

National Curriculum

As geographers we will show an understanding of the geography of Europe and its place in the wider world, learning about languages, cultures, traditions, flags, landmarks and food. We will look at how climate and environment affect human activity.

As artists we will explore the work of famous artists- Da Vincii. Picasso and Monet and compare and contrast their styles and techniques, commenting on the ideas and purposes. We will try to imitate the style of Gaudi with collage and create our own 3D Gaudi style buildings with wire. We will imitate the style of Paul Klee self portraits using various media.

Speaking and Listening

We will generate questions about countries from pictures or videos. In small groups we will research and present information about a country in Europe showing how it is different to our country.

We will talk about our art work and the work of others commenting on ideas and purposes that we encounter.

Writing Opportunities

We will write in detail a biography of the life of a European artist. We will write a report about a European country, commenting on culture, clothes, food etc. We will write a tourist information leaflet about a place of interest in

In connection will Dali/Chagall we will write about a dream we have had.

Maths Opportunities

We will read maps using grid references.

We will convert Euros and sterling and create a conversion graph. We will plan a journey using plane and train timetables.

We will develop understanding and discuss why people work and the different jobs people do in the tourist industry.
