

National Curriculum

As geographers we will show an understanding of the geography of Europe and its place in the wider world, learning about languages, cultures, traditions, flags, landmarks and food.

As artists we will explore the work of famous artists such as: Gaudi, Da Vinci, Picasso, Turner and Monet and compare and contrast their styles and techniques, commenting on the ideas and purposes. We will try to imitate the style of Gaudi by creating our own 3D lizards.



Speaking and Listening

Within our P4C sessions, we will generate questions about the different traditions in European countries. We will then put across our opinions about each one. In small groups we will research and present information about a country in Europe showing how it is different to our country. We will talk about our art work and the work of others commenting on ideas and purposes that we encounter.

Writing Opportunities

We will write in detail a biography of the life of the artist, Antoni Gaudi.
We will write a report about a country's tradition, commenting on the way that it is carried out and by whom.
We will write a tourist information leaflet about a place of interest in Europe.

Maths Opportunities

We will read maps using grid references.
We will look at European flags and the symmetry within them.
We will look at the 8 different compass points.
We will convert Euros and sterling and create a conversion graph.

We will develop an understanding of how cultures change between different countries and how they vary to ours. We will also discuss their importance and relevance in 2016.
