





National Curriculum

As Historians we will learn about the history of the Anglo Saxons in Britain.

This will include, exploring who they were, why they came to Britain, what their culture and home-life was like,

As Geographers, we will locate where the Anglo Saxons came from and where they settled on a map and note the significance of choosing Britain to invade. We will also describe the physical characteristics of where they lived and any changes that occurred as a result of their occupation.

As artists. we will re create the Bayeux tapestry and use rags of materials to create weaves like the Anglo Saxons did.

We will be looking at the work of Jasper Johns to inspire our work with Anglo Saxon runes.

Speaking and Listening

We will work towards researching and presenting our findings about different Anglo Saxon settlements to a small group.

We will take part in a debate about Anglo Saxons and Vikings.

We also will take part in role play activities of an Anglo Saxon attempted invasion.

Writing Opportunities

During Literacy sessions, we will be focussing on our sentence structure. We are going to look at the work of Alan Peat to help us structure our sentences in different ways.

We will be reading and re telling the story of Beowulf which is an old tale from Anglo Saxon times.

Maths Opportunities

During Numeracy sessions will be consolidating and extending our work with the four number operations. Some of us will be working with level 5 problems.

We are going to be using decimal numbers in daily maths meet to convert different capacities into different units of measurement.

Social, Moral, Spiritual, Cultural

We will learn about what life was like in an Anglo Saxon town and how food and fashion has changed since that time.

We will explore our feelings when we read the stories about what the Anglo Saxon did and how they lived.
