

National Curriculum

As geographers we will develop an understanding of the geography of the world. We will research different countries from around the world and find out about their Geographical features.

In addition to this, we will focus on cities in South America and compare them with Tranmere.

As historians we will study natural disasters and place them in chronological order on a timeline.

As artists we will look at well known landmarks from around the world and produce large scale pieces of art using a variety of media. We will be designing and making healthy drinks from around the world and making airline eye masks.



Speaking and Listening

We will generate questions about continents, countries and cities from pictures and videos in our P4C sessions. In small groups we will research and present information about places around the world and how they are different to our local area. We will record a radio advert for an airline we have created. We will talk about our art work and the work of others commenting on ideas and purposes that we encounter.

Writing Opportunities

We will research and present fact files about continents and countries around the world.

We will be creating in-flight magazines and advertising an airline that we have invented.

We will be studying the text '80 Days Around the World'.

Maths Opportunities

We will read maps using grid references. Through topic we will explore co-ordinates.

We will create our own maps using google maps and highlight significant places, locating them using grid references.

Social, Moral, Spiritual, Cultural

We will learn about the different continents and cultural traditions related to those places.

We will practise holding debates on moral issues in our P4C sessions.
