Governor observations and comments The children were in year 5 at the time of the inspection. They had a clear timetable based around an official Ofsted visit and some lines of enquiry to follow. The pupils talked confidently about their observations and we had a long discussion about the number of children arriving late for school which they found very worrying. Following the Pupil Ofsted they worked with Hannah Passmore in order to put a report together which was really interesting and had taken a lot of time and effort. Each section described things they had liked and areas which might be improved – just like a real Ofsted!	
Any key issues arising for the governing body It may be interesting for a small group of pupils to learn about budget setting and how the administration of the school is carried out.
