

Holidays During Term-time

School strongly discourages absence from school due to family holidays as it is highly disruptive to children's education and is seen to have a negative impact on their self-esteem and confidence. If you need to take your child out of school during term time, please complete a leave of absence form available from the office. School will let you know if this holiday can be authorised due to special circumstances. The families of 13 pupils have received Education Penalty Notices so far this year, due to taking holidays during term time, which were not authorised. Payment of an Education Penalty Notice is £60 if paid within 21 days and £120 if paid after this time but within 28 days. Penalty Notices will be issued to each parent for each child.
