Foundation 1



Foundation 1 have been very busy this term. They have been finding out all about changes. First the children brought baby photographs from home and eagerly talked about how they had changed. This was explored further in a P4C session where the children discussed whether they would prefer to be a baby or a child. They thought very carefully and were able to give some reasons for their preferences. The children enjoyed looking after



babies in the role play area and explored colour mixing with the paint, creating fabulous paintings of babies which were completed by cutting pieces of a real nappy and sticking them onto their paintings!



Following this the children thought about jobs that they would like to do when they grow up. They enjoyed dressing up and taking on the role of who they were dressed as.

The children have also planted bean and sunflower seeds and watched how they grew into a beautiful beanstalk and flower. They painted sunflowers, mixing yellow and red paint to make shades of orange and added sunflower seeds to the centre of their master pieces!



The Foundation 1 will children will begin their transition into Foundation 2 over the next few weeks. They will be visited by their new teachers and also have the opportunity to go into their Foundation 2 classroom and outdoor area.

The sessions will highlight the importance of the parents being their child's first teacher and include stories, rhymes, activities and time for the children's carers to share their experiences.
