Ideas for things to do at home

Hello F2. We hope you're enjoying your time at home with your grown-ups and you're learning lots of new and exciting things. Here are some more fun things for you to try. Remember to keep sharing them on Tapestry!

1. Make salt dough and Easter Decorations!

You will need:

- 2 cups flour
- 1 cup salt
- 1 cup water
- Food colouring (optional)



1. Mix together the flour and salt in a large mixing bowl.
2. If desired, add 5-10 drops of food colouring to 1 cup of water.
3. Stir the water into the flour and salt in the large bowl.
4. Roll out the dough on a flat surface and knead it together. It should be soft and pliable.
5. Make Easter models and decorations.
6. The dough can be left to air dry. The time the dough takes to dry will depend on the size and thickness of your creations.

2. Draw a story map
