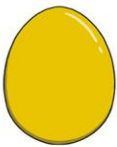
Art and Design

Draw a picture of the Giant. Can you find somethings around the house to use for his buttons? Hair? Shirt? Boot laces?

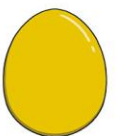


Phonics
