


Week beginning 15th June 2020

Potions Art

You will need a white wax crayon, a piece of paper, felt tip pens, some foil and a water spray.

First draw the outline of a potion bottle and then using the white wax crayon create some patterns inside it.

Now using felt tip pens colour over the foil in any way you wish.

Spray the foil with water, then flip it over onto your potion bottle. Push down well and the pens will rub onto your drawing.

If you have black paper, they look great cut out and backed onto it.



Save a number of plastic bottles to make skittles or targets.

Write a number (perhaps 1 to 10) on each one and stand them in a bowling pin arrangement.

Using either a ball or a water pistol what different totals can you make by knocking them down? What's the highest number you can make? Can you score an odd number? Can you score less than 8?

Water Walking

You'll need six containers of water for this one: three with clear water, one with red food colouring, one with blue colouring, and one with yellow colouring.

Arrange them in a circle, alternating coloured and clear containers, and make bridges between the containers with folded paper towels.

You will be amazed to see the coloured water "walk" over the bridges and into the clear containers, mixing colours, and giving a first-hand look at the magic of movement.

To help you out we'll give you:


O - Oman Q - Qatar Y - Yemen
