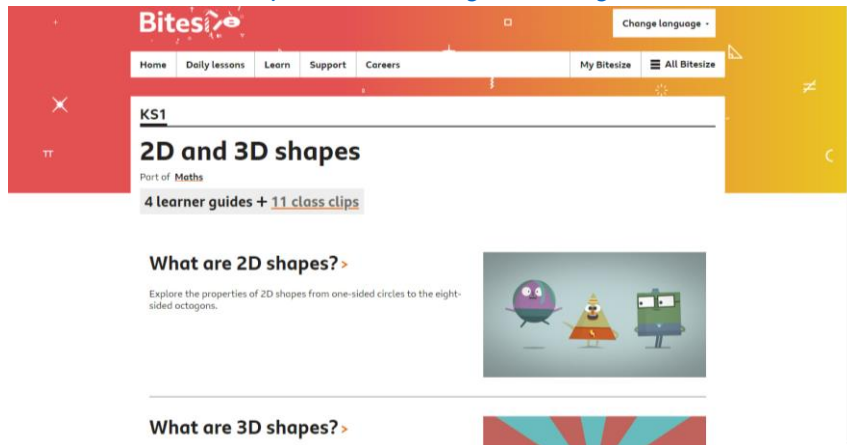


Hello again Year 1! It is lovely to see you back in school this week. Keep looking out on Purple Mash for new 2Dos and Bug Club for new books each day.

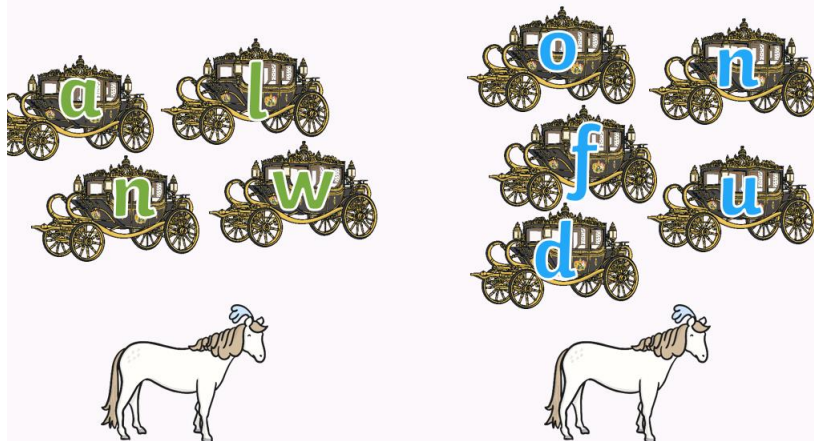

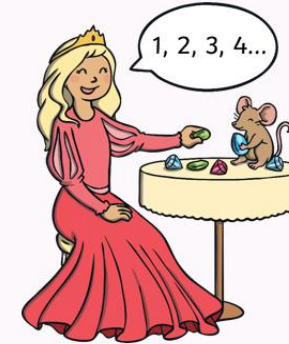
### Jumbled Words
