

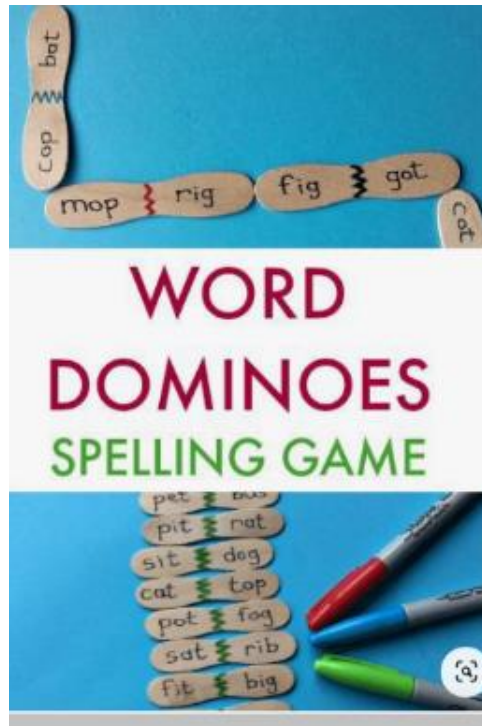
Week beginning 1st June 2020

Phonics:

If you have any lollipop sticks at home you could make your own phonics dominos game. Each stick will have a line drawn down the middle and on each half write a word. You have to match the sticks that have the same digraph on. For example
rain → train
bee → tree
play → stay



Literacy:

Create your own story. Can you use this picture prompt to help write your own imaginative story. How did this pirate get stuck on a island? Think about what his name might be? What was he doing and where did he come from?

How did this pirate get stuck on a deserted island?



Crafts:

Ask your grown ups if they have any old CDs lying around your home that you could use for this craft activity.

CD Fish

You will need:

- PVA glue
- Coloured foam
- 2 old CDs
- Ribbon
- Sticky tape
- Sequins and jewels
- Googly eyes



1 Draw 2 fins, a tail piece and lips onto the coloured foam. Then cut the foam shapes out using scissors.



2 Tie a length of ribbon into a loop. Then tape this onto the non-shiny side of one of the disks.



3 Using PVA glue, stick the fins, tail and lips onto the non-shiny side of the CD. Do this so that they hang over the edge.



4 Take the second CD and spread PVA glue on the non-shiny side of it. Then stick this onto the back of the other CD, so that both shiny sides are visible.



5 Using PVA glue, stick a googly eye just above the fish's lips on both sides.



6 Now decorate both sides of the fish. To do this, stick sequins and jewels on using small amounts of PVA glue.

When out for your daily exercise or around your house have a look around you and see if you can spot things that are these different colours. Write down what you find and draw a picture of it.
