


Literacy:

On the 8th June it is World Oceans Day.

Scientists are finding out about ways in which we can clear the plastic from our oceans. This needs a lot of research and *innovation* because there is so much plastic in the ocean. How can you reduce your use of plastic or recycle what you do use?

Can you have a go at writing an acrostic poem using the words World Ocean Day as your starting letters for each sentence
