


Week beginning 6th July 2020

Can you spot how these shells have been sorted? Is there a different way?


Year 2 Learning Journal

Well, try making this tasty M&M or Smarties fudge with just 3 ingredients.



- 225g milk chocolate
- half a tin (approx. 200g) of condensed milk
- 120g crispy M&Ms

Break the chocolate into pieces, put in a saucepan with the condensed milk and heat until melted.

Pour half the mix into a tin and top with half the M&Ms.

Add the other half of the mixture and again top with M&Ms.

Leave to set overnight in the fridge.
