


## F1 Home Learning ideas for week beginning 18.1.2012

Hello F1, we have been missing you. We hope you are well. Here are some learning activities for you to try at home. Don't forget to post your pictures onto Tapestry for us all to see!

### **Communication and Language**

Let's talk about pigs! You can watch this video, <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=06sDgp3wZUc> or look at some pictures of them in a book or on the internet.



What do they look like? What do they do? Where do they live?  
How do they sound? Why do they roll in the mud?

### **Personal, Social and Emotional Development**

In the Story, the Wolf wasn't very kind to the Three Little Pigs. Talk to your grown-up about being kind and maybe grown-ups can think about these questions to help you.



What kind things can you do around the house?  
How can you be kind to everyone in your family?  
Why are we kind?

### **Physical Development**

Pigs are very different to humans and we must take care of ourselves in a different way! Talk to your grown-up about keeping clean and how important it is to wash our hand after we have been playing outside and before and after we eat. We sing this song at school when we wash our hands (to the tune of Row, row, row your boat)



Wash, wash, wash your hands,  
Wash nasty germs away,  
If you don't you might get ill and that would spoil your day

Sing this song two times whilst you rub the soap into your hands before rinsing it off with clean, warm water! You can also watch this video about germs and the song is at the end <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=07YNCFISOiI>

Play the game **What's the Time Mr Wolf?** Choose who is the wolf and who is the little Pig. If the wolf says it is 2 o'clock, the pig moves 2 steps closer to the wolf. If the wolf says it is 5 o'clock the pig moves 5 steps closer to the wolf. If the wolf says "Dinner Time"- little pig run!

## Mathematics



Can you make a map on the table for the wolf to find where the Little Pigs live? Using paper tape and paper arrows as well as toys, lego, bits of material to make 'trees', 'bridges', 'shops', 'rivers' etc...and you could take turns with your grown-up to direct the wolf around the map.

"Go forward two spaces" "Go around the bush" "Go over the river" "Go under the bridge"  
"Go backwards one space" "Hide next to the shop"

## Mathematics

Can you be a little Pig hiding from the wolf? Can you hide behind a tree? Can you hide under a table? Can you hide inside a wardrobe? Can you put a toy inside, under, on top of, in front of, behind, next to a box?

## Understanding the World



Can you build a house that can or can't be blown down? For example, with paper cups, lolly sticks, straws and tape, duplo, lego or wooden blocks? Which one is the strongest? You could use a hairdryer to try and blow them down!

## Expressive Arts and Design



Can you create a puppet theatre from cereal boxes? You can use kitchen roll tubes to make the pigs and the wolf. Now you can act out the story by yourself or with a grown-up!
