
Personal, Social and Emotional Development / Communication and Language

Talk about feelings of love!

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| <p><u>Who is special to us?</u> (Mummy, Daddy, brothers and sisters, other family, friends)</p>  | <p><u>What is love?</u> (when you really care for someone or something)</p>  | <p><u>How does it make you feel?</u> (a nice feeling / it makes you feel happy / it makes you smile)</p>  |
| <p><u>How might we show love?</u> (cuddles/kisses/holding hands, doing something kind for someone, taking care of someone if they are poorly, sharing, playing, surprising someone with something nice, being gentle)</p>  | <p><u>Who would you like to send a Valentine's Day card to?</u> (Someone you love - Mummy, Daddy, brothers and sisters, other family, friends)</p>  | <p><u>How do people feel when they get a Valentine's card?</u> (Happy / excited / loved / cared for)</p>  |

Can you read another story about feelings? A good one is 'Sometimes I feel Sunny' by Gillian Shield. Talk together about all the different feelings in the story.

Can you 'write' and post some Valentine's day cards?

- Practice folding pieces of paper or card to make a card
- Sign your card by writing your name inside, writing just one letter from your name or some special marks or a picture of yourself instead. You could draw love hearts too in shades of red and pink.
- Make a 'post box' out of an old cardboard box - a shoe box is good for this! Remember to ask a grown-up to cut out the hole for the letters to go in. Make the hole thinner so it's trickier to post them - this is good for hand-eye co-ordination!

Can you practice your skills of jumping, hopping, and standing still on one foot?

How many star jumps can you do in 30 seconds?




Roses are Red, Violets are blue

Mathematics




Take out all the 'hearts' from a pack of cards at home (if you don't have any you could make some out of paper!).

Remember the A = 1!

- Put them in order, counting the hearts
- Put them in order looking at the numerals
- Find that many objects from around the house and put them next to the card e.g. find 2 pieces of Lego and put them next to the 2 card.
- Lay the cards face down, pick a card and blow each other that many kisses/give that many cuddles/say 'love' that many times
- If you do have a whole pack of cards, can you find the other 2's/3's/4's etc... and group them all together? How many 4's are there in a pack? How many 10's?

You could go on a 2D shape hunt around your home. Can you find any objects which are circle in shape, any objects which are triangle in shape and any which are square or rectangle in shape?



Can you use coloured crayons or coloured toys to make a repeating pattern?

For example

- Make Valentine's Day cards
- Paint a heart. Can you mix red and white paint to make pink?
- Print pictures with heart shaped objects e.g. potato printing, a heart shaped biscuit cutter dipped in paint
- Make red playdough or use brown playdough and an old chocolate box!
