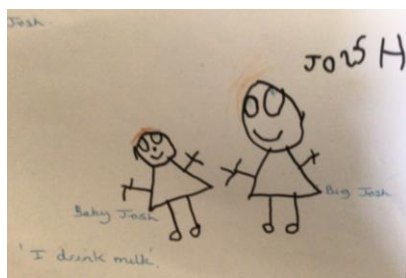


**Foundation Stage**

**Summer Term 2021**

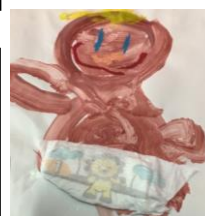
