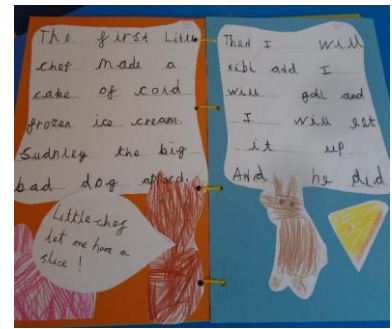
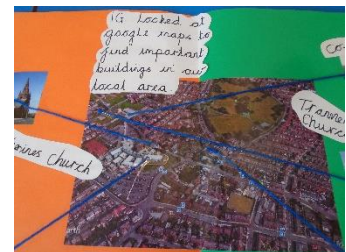
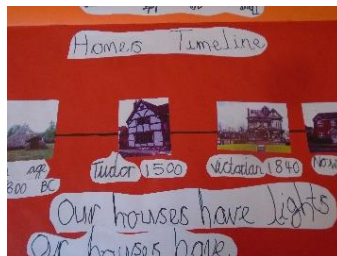


**Key Stage One**

In Maths the children have been challenged by their teachers and have been working with 2 digit numbers. They have learned how to partition and represent them in lots of different ways.



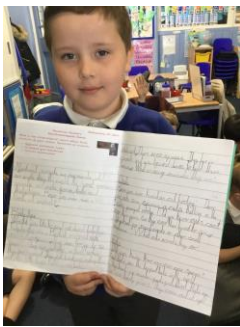
During Science lessons the children have been investigating and comparing plants and trees in the local environment.

Year One have continued to work on their Buildings topic this half term and have been finding out about important buildings in their local area, about buildings long ago and have compared the countryside with the town.



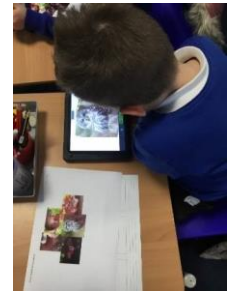
## Year Two
