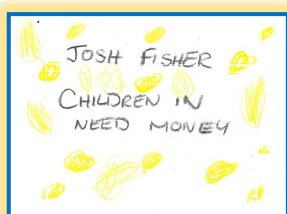
## Headteacher's Newsletter - December 2021

## Please wear a face mask

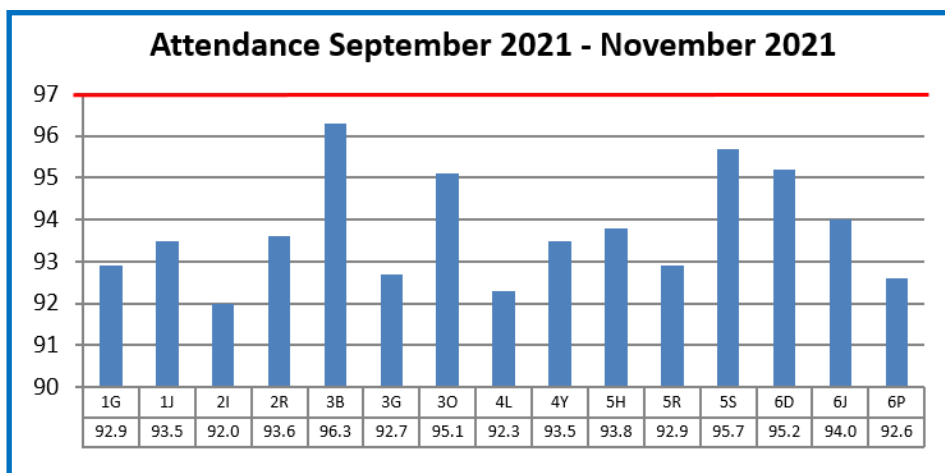
Following new COVID guidelines, please could we remind all parents, carers and visitors to school that masks **must** be worn when entering the school building.

## Attendance

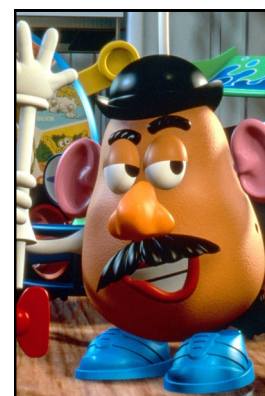
Current whole school attendance is 94.6%, which has improved in the last month. The class with the best attendance so far this year is still **3B** with 96.3% - congratulations! All the other classes with attendance below the red line are working hard in school to try to improve their attendance. Well done to **1J**, **2I**, **2R**, **4L**, **5S** and **6J** who have successfully improved their class attendance, during October.



Can parents/carers please ensure that if children are absent from school that a reason is provided every day, so we are able to authorise the absence. If we are not informed of the reason or if the reason is not acceptable, then the absence will be marked as unauthorised. Ten sessions (five days) of unauthorised absence within two half terms may incur an Education Penalty Notice, the cost of which is £60 per child for each parent, if paid in the first 21 days.

Each class is working hard to gain parts for their Potato Head. Every week classes that have an attendance of 97% or more can choose which body part they would like to add. Look out for photos on Twitter to see which class have the best looking Potato Head so far this year!
