The Summer Reading Challenge combines **FREE** access to books with fun, creative

activities during the summer holidays. Throughout the Challenge, library staff support the children, helping them to discover new authors and

illustrators and to explore a wide range of different types of books and ways of reading.

How the Challenge works

- Children sign up through their local library and receive a Gadgeteers collector poster.
- Children set a reading goal and borrow and read library books of their own choice during the summer, collecting special stickers to complete their poster and extra incentives along the way.
- Library staff are on hand to advise and run family-friendly activities.
- All children who take part receive a certificate
- Children who complete the Summer Reading Challenge are presented with a certificate and a medal.



Attendance

Current whole school attendance is 94% which is well below our school target of 97%. The class with the best attendance so far this year continues to be **3B** with 95.9% - congratulations! All the classes in school are working hard to try to improve their attendance. Well done to **4L**, **4Y** and **5H** who have successfully improved their class attendance, during May.



Congratulations also, to 145 pupils in school who have attendance of 97% or higher.

Absence due to Illness

If a pupil is off school as they are unwell, it is vital that school is informed on the first day of absence either by phone call, written note, verbal message to a member of staff on the gate or in the office or through the Parent app. Please continue to keep school informed every day your child continues to need to stay off school.

Parents/carers may be asked to provide medical evidence in order for school to authorise absences. This can take the form of: a doctor's certificate; an appointment card - date stamped; medication in the name of the child; a prescription; a text message from doctors or the NHS confirming an appointment; care of the chemist date stamped slip to show medical advice has been sought; or appointment letters from hospital, doctor or dentist.
