<b>Purpose of planned visit:</b>  Discussion with Maths Lead Becky Eccles- Curriculum update	
<b>Links with the School Development Plan (SDP)</b>  Raise attainment in Maths.	
<b>Governor observations and comments:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Becky updated me on Curriculum policy and development of new initiatives</li><li>Intent statement shared</li><li>Maths Calculation policy has been updated in year groups</li><li>Implementation and Catch up plans shared with me</li><li>An equipment audit has taken place and new resources have been ordered</li><li>Knowledge organisers have been introduced itemising essential information and points of reference</li><li>Staff are using White Rose, Power Maths, Twinkle and Mastery documents to plan, which are then personalised and tailored to the children's needs</li><li>Maths Lead has done drop ins checking that equipment, correct Maths vocab was being used properly and staff are adapting the curriculum and resources to meet needs of all</li><li>Rote learning and use of Maths dictionaries are planned for</li><li>Pupil interviews showed that children can articulate their learning</li><li>SLT had done a book scrutiny looking at progression in books from years 1 to 6</li><li>Inclusion – <b>SEND</b> children working at same level but work was scaffolded <b>MA</b> – had a spicy challenge and questions were more open ended</li><li>Assessment – using Maths facts tests, Ready to Progress document and Power Maths tests. These are used for target setting and are timed age appropriate and then put on Primary Target Tracker</li><li>New Y4 times table tests are done regularly, timed and booklets have been produced</li><li>"If you know" teaching strategies are in place i.e. <math>5+2=7</math> so you can draw it, discuss inverse and other near or larger facts</li></ul>	
<b>Any key issues arising for the governing body:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Governors to continue to fund new resources</li><li>Maths Governor to see all above in classrooms</li></ul>	
<b>Action following governing body meeting:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Governors to continue tracking Maths attainment and progress across the school from our detailed HT reports</li><li>A big thank you to Becky for a very informative update and showing me her very detailed policy file.
