Of the many things that the children have learnt this year:

The Year 1 classes were very fortunate to visit St Cath's and learn all about the 'ins and outs' of a church. They also thoroughly enjoyed exploring the topic, 'Sea in the Bible' with Charlotte Kirkham.

Year 2 also, learnt a lot from Charlotte when they looked at 'The rules we live by' and when they explored the Easter Story in school.
