PSHE Subject Leader's Report July 2024

We have continued to teach the PSHE curriculum through the use of the Jigsaw scheme. This has been adapted to meet the needs of our school and continues to be regularly checked to ensure all of the materials and lessons are up to date and relevant.





The children also participate in regular P4C sessions and discuss important issues through the use of the 'No Outsiders' books.

myHappymind has been further consolidated within school. Last year we were worked towards and gained the Bronze Award, and hope to work towards the Silver Award. Funding for myHappymind continued in the 2023-2024 academic year. Children continue to use the 'Happy Breathing' and the My Happy Mind areas around school are an important place of sanctuary for many children. More parents are accessing support thought the myHappymind parent app and school will continue to encourage parents to download this.

As part of the PSHE curriculum, the teachers have led the Jigsaw specific RSE lessons, all of which have been successful and well received by the parents and children.
