In our literacy lessons, we will be reading FArTHER, a story about World War 1

Reading and Spelling


In our reading we will be focussing on explaining the meaning of words in context and identifying how meaning is enhanced through choice of words and phrases. We will be learning these spelling patterns each week and we will be looking out for them in our reading books; Suffixes: -ant, -ance, -ent, -ence, -able, -ible, -ably, -ibly We will also be looking for these common exception words; accommodate, available, controversy, dictionary marvellous. opportunity, secretary, sincerely, suggest, twelfth

Maths

In our maths lessons we will be solving multiplication and division problems. We will also be revising formal written methods for addition and subtraction.

We will look at finding the perimeter and area of a shape.

We will interpret information from a variety of graphs and tables.



Foundation Subjects

Our topic this half term will be Ancient Greeks.

As historians, we will find out about the Battle of Marathon. We will compare and contrast the ancient states of Athens and Sparta. We will also investigate the importance of theatre in the culture of Ancient Greece.



As artists we will look at buildings and imagine ourselves as architects. We will look at Greek buildings and practice proportion and shading.

In PE we will be learning the skills of Tag Rugby and implementing them into a game.

Science

In science we will be learning all about Forces. We will explain that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of the force of gravity acting between the Earth and the falling object. We will identify the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction, that act between moving surfaces. We will recognise that some mechanisms, including levers, pulleys and gears, allow a smaller force to have a greater effect.

We will also find out about the famous scientists Sir Isaac Newton and Galileo.
