<u>Maths</u>

In our maths lessons we will be looking at the value of numbers to 10. We will do lots of investigating about each number to 10; learning about number bonds for each number and finding out one more and one less. We will make each number to 10 in a variety of different ways to ensure we have a secure knowledge of the value of each number. We will then look at comparing and ordering numbers to 10. We will also learn about ordinal numbers.



Our topic this half term is 'Sensational Seasons'. As geographers we will look at weather patterns in our local area and around the world. We will compare hot and cold areas of the world as well as locating the North

Pole, South Pole and Equator. We will also look at the changes we see in weather and the trees as we move through the seasons. As artists we will creating woven wonders through our craft and design unit.

Science

In science we will be starting our work about Animals, including Humans. We will identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals. We will also identify and name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. We will look at which animals would make good pets and explain why we might not want a tiger for a pet! We will also look at naming body parts and our five senses. We will also learn all about some very interesting people such as George Mottershead, Carl Hagenbeck and Linda Brown Buck.
