

Mersey Park Half Term Overview Spring 1 Year 1



Writing

In our literacy lessons we will be learning the story of The Gingerbread Man. We will write a description of the gingerbread man focussing on using power adjectives and will retell the story of what happens to the gingerbread man. We will also write instructions on how to make a Gingerbread Man.

We will continue to work on writing in full sentences and using capital letters at the start of our sentences and full stops at the end. We will also start to look at how to use question marks and exclamation marks

in our writing. ingredients, recipe.

Reading and Phonics

In our reading we will be learning to sound out the words in our books and use our phonics to help us.

We will be continuing to learn phase 5 graphemes such as;

Maths

In our maths lessons we will be looking at addition and subtraction within numbers to 20. We will use part whole models and bar models to help us with our calculations. We will start to look at multiplication and division. We will use counters to help us make groups to count to find the total in a multiplication problem or share out between groups to find the answer to a division problem. We will combine ICT and Maths when we start to look at position and direction. We will describe movement using language such as; quarter turn, half turn, full turn.

Foundation Subjects

Our topic this half term is 'Food'. As geographers we will look at traditional foods from different European countries such as Spain, France, Germany and Italy. We will find these countries on a map and look at their location compared to the UK. We will revise the four countries of the UK. As historians we will look at food our parents/ grandparents ate at home and at school when they were younger. As artists, we will explore drawing by creating different types of lines and mark making.

Science

In science we will learn about 'Materials'. We will describe the physical properties of a variety of everyday materials. We will compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple properties. We will name, identify and describe the properties of different materials, for example wood, metal, plastic, rubber, fur, towelling, nylon, wool, sponge, cotton wool, paper, card, brick, ceramics and rock. We will also label, collect and group together objects made from the same material. We will look at why some materials are unsuitable for some objects.
