Writing

In our literacy lessons we will be learning the story of Not Now Bernard. We will create a story map, retell the story and then we will have a go at changing the story by adding our own characters. We will also write character descriptions of the monster in our story, focusing on using 2A sentences (2 adjectives), questions and exclamations. We will also read 'The Flower' by John Light and develop our comprehension skills through retrieval, prediction and explain.

Reading and Spelling

In our reading we will be continuing to sound out longer trickier words and trying to read most familiar words fluently.

We will be learning these sounds in spellings and looking out for them in our reading books;

/i/ – y
es, ed, er – y to i
e - ing

We will also be looking for these tricky words; every, everybody, even, great, break, steak, pretty, beautiful, after, fast

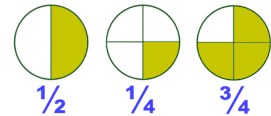
We will continue to apply our comprehension skills by answering questions about the books we are reading.



Maths

In our maths lessons we will be looking at multiplication and division. We will use part whole models and bar models to help us complete calculations. We will draw arrays and apply our knowledge of counting in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s. We will also find out about measure including; length, height, weight and capacity.

We will learn about fractions of shapes and amounts. We will learn how to find half, quarter, three quarters and a third of a numbers and shapes. We will learn how to tell the time to o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to.



Foundation Subjects

Our topic 'Fire Fire' will continue this half term. We will learn even more about The Great Fire of London. As historians we will look at the diary of Samuel Pepys and compare his account of the fire with other sources of evidence and use this to complete the timeline. As geographers we will study the rebuilding of the city and famous architects. As artists we will sketch the basic shapes and outlines of our favourite toys.

Science

In science we will be learning all about 'Animals, including Humans'. We will describe the importance of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food and hygiene. We will find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air) and will consider what humans need to live. We will identify different foods and classify some of the foods that humans eat by plant or animal origins. We will describe how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals, using the idea of a simple food chain, and identify and name different sources of food. We will identify and create a simple food chain.
