Writing

In our literacy lessons we will continue to read and enjoy the story of 'The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane' by Kate DiCamillo.

We will be writing poetry about our senses inspired by the book and continue to develop our descriptive writing.



Reading and Spelling

In our reading we will be focussing on fluency when reading aloud. We will continue to answer a range of comprehension questions. We will be learning these spelling patterns each week and we will be looking out for them in our reading books; /au/ - or, Suffixes; ly, -ion following 't', 'te', -ion following 'ss', 'mit, 'cion' following 'c', 'cs', We will also be looking for these tricky words; group, height, particular, potatoes, separate, surprise, through, various, though, woman

Maths

In our maths lessons we will be focussing on fractions. We will learn how to convert improper fractions to mixed numbers. We will also look at equivalent fractions.

We will continue to practise our multiplication up to 12x in preparation for our times tables test in the summer.

Foundation Subjects


This half term we will be continuing our topic of 'Passport to Europe'. As geographers we will revise and embed our knowledge of the location of the seven continents on a world map and the five oceans. We will focus on European countries such as; Spain, France, Italy, Finland, Austria and Russia. We will study and compare their human and physical geographical features. We will study an area in Spain called Andalucía and compare it with the Wirral. As artists we will continue to study the fabric of nature and learn how to present our work to a high standard. In computing we will use Scratch to create a game using forever loops. In RE we will be discussing the question 'Who is Jesus really?'. In PE we will play invasion games such as Football and Netball.
