Year 1

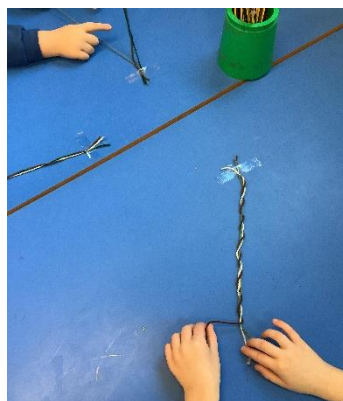
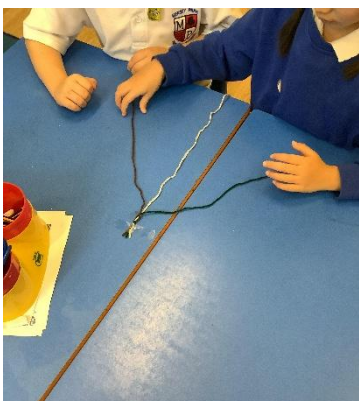
